ORDER

1. The petition under consideration is a letter bearing Number 1-1(280)/ELE/2009/1276 dated 15.07.2009 from the Deputy Secretary (Power), Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli (U.T.), Electricity Department, Silvassa, intimating the Commission that for meeting the increasing demand, the Petitioner is initiating a process for procurement of 100 MW of power, round-the-clock, on short-term basis, from 01.09.2009 to 31.08.2010.

2. The Petitioner made a presentation on the power demand and supply situation in the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli.
3. The petitioner was advised that under the provisions of section 86(1) (b) of the electricity Act only informing the appropriate Commission about procurement of power by the licensee was not enough.
4. As per Section 86(1)(b) of the Electricity Act, 2003, it is the Commission that has been entrusted with the task to regulate electricity purchase and procurement process of distribution licensees (the Petitioner herein), including the price at which electricity shall be procured from the generating companies or licensees or from other sources through agreements for purchase of power for distribution and supply.
5. The petitioner was advised that it was incumbent on them to establish and justify the requirement of the quantum of power sought to be procured, indicate the source of procurement, the price, and how the transparency in the procurement process is going to be ensured.
6. In the result, the petition is not admitted, being not maintainable.
7. The Petitioner will, however, have the liberty, should it so desire, of filing a fresh petition giving all the details and in accordance with the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission for State Goa and UTs (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2009.
