**ORDER**

1. The petition under consideration is a letter No. 1-1(249)/ELE/2008/334 dated 19.02.09 from Deputy Secretary (Power), DN&H Administration intimating the Commission that in absence of the Open Access regulations they intend to adopt the CERC regulations on Open Access (Para 16.1) for fixing transmission charges.

2. The petitioner submitted that they are in receipt of number of applications from high end industrial consumers for allowing Open Access and therefore they requested the Commission to publish Open Access charges.
3. The Commission observed that its regulations regarding open access were under preparation but was of the view that non availability of the regulations should not come in the way of allowing open access in deserving cases and therefore it may consider to allow deserving consumers open access by following case to case approach. The adoption of CERC regulations on open access as proposed may not serve the intended purpose.
4. The petitioner was therefore advised, should they so desire, to come with a comprehensive proposal which specifies different charges such as inter-state transmission charges, intra-state transmission charges, distribution wheeling charges, loss levels, cross subsidy surcharge, additional surcharge, connected load etc. for seeking Commission approval on case to case basis.
